Nomination Deadlines	<p>Full Year and Autumn semester entry 31 May</p> <p>Spring semester entry 31 October</p>
Application Deadlines	<p>Full Year and Autumn semester entry 30 June</p> <p>Spring semester entry 30 November</p>
Academic requirement	<p>All incoming exchange/study abroad students must meet our academic requirement of a GPA of at least 3.0 or equivalent. This is assessed by submission of a recent academic transcript.</p>
Module Selection	<p>Students may choose modules from a range of subjects or take a more focused approach by choosing to specialise in a specific area. This will depend on the terms of our institution agreement. Students may need permission from their home institution to study certain modules if restricted to a subject area.</p> <p>Students will be required to undertake three 20 UK credit modules per semester which is equal to 60 UK credits or 120 credits for the full academic year. Please note: A 20 UK credit module is worth 10 ECTS credits or 5 US credits.</p> <p>Students will be required to select their module preferences prior to their arrival to Ulster and will be asked to submit a module request form. All modules must be selected from our module lists by Belfast, Coleraine and Derry~Londonderry campus as these are modules that have been verified as the suitable for study abroad/exchange students.</p> <p>Further information: www.ulster.ac.uk/global/study-abroad/modules</p>

<p>Academic documents required to be submitted</p>	<p>1. Transcript</p> <p>All applicants must submit their most recent academic transcript as part of the application process. All transcripts submitted must be official and in English and include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name of home institution/university • Name of programme of study, course or major • List of all completed modules (courses) to date • GPA or equivalent <p>Please note: If original transcript is not in English, an official translation is required (stamped by an official translator).</p> <p>2. English Language Requirements</p> <p>All international applicants (EU NATIONALS INCLUDED) are required to provide evidence that they have meet one of our English Language requirements as indicated:</p> <p>www.ulster.ac.uk/global/apply/english-language-requirements</p> <p>3. Passport</p> <p>All applicants are required to send a copy of their valid passport. Passports will need to remain valid for the entirety of the programme stay plus 6 months</p> <p>4. Portfolio</p> <p>For students wishing to study within the Belfast School of Art or Architecture, an e-portfolio will be required clearly showing practical experience in the areas they wish to study in.</p>
